Article IV Section 4.02 of the By-Laws

Article IV Section 4.02 Board Of Trustees Number and Qualifications

(Current wording last sentence)

Any Trustee elected by its Beneficial Members must be a Member of the Association.

(Proposed wording last sentence)-

Any candidate for Trustee elected by the members of the association, must be:

- **A Member of the Association *that is comprised of its beneficial members and / or a resident that has their home in the community as their primary residence***
- **Fifty-five years of age or older**

Reason:

This By-Law is modified to revise the eligibility requirements for candidates for the Board of Trustees which is currently exclusive to Members of the Association who are on title to a home in the community.

- ***Any resident including beneficial members, regardless if they are not named on the beneficial member's deed or title, should not be prohibited from having the right to be a candidate for the Board.***
- ***Trustees should also have their home within the community as their primary residence and with the same age restriction for home ownership to ensure that Board members are more representative of the community's membership.***
